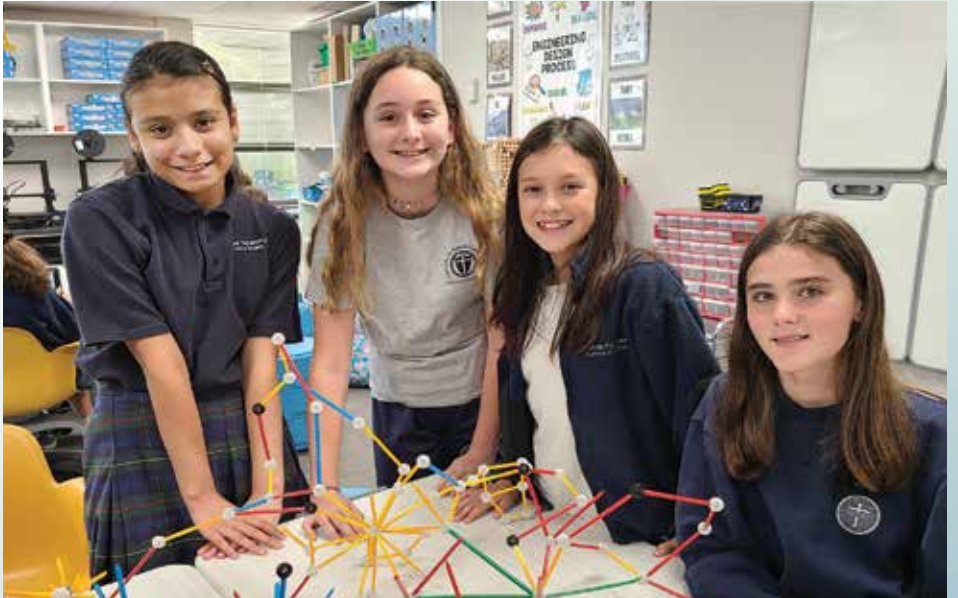

Founded in 1962, Saint Jude the Apostle Catholic School is a welcoming, thriving, faith-based community of faculty and families working together to prepare students for not only higher education, but for life.

We are thrilled to be celebrating 60 years of academic excellence this '22-'23 school year! Serving students from kindergarten through eighth grade, our teachers average 15 years of teaching experience. As a twice recognized National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence (2003 & 2014), we offer a competitive academic program with a balance of core classes, STREAM, arts, physical education, grammar and handwriting, religion, and foreign language. In addition, we have a range of athletic and extracurricular activities, before and after school programs, field trips, service projects, and retreats.

Technology

Saint Jude the Apostle Catholic School recognizes the value of technology in the classroom as a teaching tool for our students to develop skills needed for success. Saint Jude School is a Google Apps for Education school. Every student in the school is issued their own device. Students in grades K and 1 each have an iPad. Students in grades 2-8 each have a Chromebook.

In grades K-1, students use their assigned iPad to access apps to complete tasks and projects that reinforce daily learning.

Students will also use apps and programs to create their own authentic work, demonstrating knowledge and understanding of material presented.

In grades 2-8, students use their assigned Chromebook to access learning resources, class notes, individual and group projects, teacher communication, and other information. Students use their Chromebook throughout the day as needed for instruction in each subject area.

All classrooms contain an interactive LCD Projector/whiteboard that is connected to the teacher computer for viewing class materials and curriculum resources.

In enrichment classes, our students use their 1:1 device to enhance learning in Spanish, media, STREAM, art, and music.

Technology class is scheduled once a week for all grade levels. Students complete activities that support learning, as well as build researching and coding skills.

Media Center staff meet weekly with each homeroom to ignite a love for reading, instruct students on how to use the library management system, and guide students in online research. The Media Center is also equipped with a state-of-the-art broadcast studio. The student-led news crew delivers a *Morning Prayer* and *News Show* daily.



This year's *Bats & Ballgowns* auction held at the Omni Battery hotel at Truist Park on February 12, 2022, was a grand slam! Over 250 parents, faculty, staff, and friends celebrated our wonderful school community!

Together, we raised over **\$167,000** and achieved our goal of upgrading our playground, adding an outdoor classroom, and creating an honorary brick path in Mary's Garden. We are extremely grateful to our co-chairs Siobhan Finnegan, Laurie Miller, and Stephanie Smith and to all our sponsors, parents, and volunteers! Kindergarten

Toy Drive benefiting Lift Up Atlanta

In December, our youngest students held a *Toy Drive* to support *Lift Up Atlanta*, an organization that provides homeless and low-income families in the metro Atlanta area safe housing, food, clothing, and other services designed to help them meet their basic needs and to empower them to reach self-sufficiency. Lift Up Atlanta’s goal this year was to provide new toys to at least 300 children. The kindergarten Toy Drive was a huge success collecting over 300 toys. Our little ones certainly know how to spread some joy!

1st Grade

Animal Shelter Drive

In honor of Saint Francis Day, the first graders collected donations to support the *Atlanta Humane Society*. Over 137 pounds of Milk-Bones, dog toys, cat supplies, collars, leashes, and gift cards were collected!

2nd Grade

Our House Day Care Center

In September, our 2nd graders promoted a school-wide *Diaper Drive* in partnership with Our House, a charitable organization in our community that provides day care and support for homeless families. *Our House* received more than 8,000 diapers and over 14,000 baby wipes, plus other much needed items for the homeless families they serve.



3rd Grade

St. Joseph Place

Our sweet 3rd grade students lifted the hearts of the residents at *St. Joseph Place* in Southwest Atlanta by making 64 Easter bags filled with necessities and goodies for the seniors to enjoy.

4th Grade

Men's Homeless Shelter at Shrine of the Immaculate Conception and Central Presbyterian Church

The 4th grade students provided 390 meal bags (breakfast, lunch, and dinner!) for men at *Central Night Presbyterian and Shrine of the Immaculate Conception* homeless shelters. The churches provide meals and a bed to homeless men of Atlanta.

5th Grade

Community Assistance Center

The 5th grade class sponsored a school-wide *Canned Food Drive* in March to help fill the shelves at the Community Assistance Center (CAC) in Sandy Springs. This year, they collected over 1000 pounds of food to help stock the shelves at the CAC. The CAC supports individuals and families in need.

6th Grade

The Sandwich Project

In March, our 6th grade students worked in partnership with *The Sandwich Project (TSP)* and made 460 deli meat and cheese sandwiches in addition to 132 bagels with cream cheese to help TSP meet the food scarcity needs in Metro Atlanta. Students also crafted homemade cards with a sweet note of encouragement.

7th Grade

Solidarity Sandy Springs

Our 7th grade students partnered with *Solidarity Sandy Springs* to help assist local families in our community that are in need by helping them feel uplifted, supported, and food secure. The students made 50 Easter baskets filled with family fun and blessings!

8th Grade

Hope Atlanta

In April, the 8th graders made nine full "move-in" kits which provided household essentials to help families transitioning out of homelessness – each kit included a *Bless this Home* canvas and *Joy Jars*.

8th Grade

Daffodil Project

The 8th grade took part in *The Daffodil Project*, which aspires to build a Living Holocaust Memorial by planting 1.5 million daffodils around the world in memory of the 1.5 million children who were murdered during the Holocaust. Our students planted 500 daffodils along the path of the Stations of the Cross between the rectory and school. To date, our Saint Jude 8th graders have planted over 5,000 daffodils since 2014.

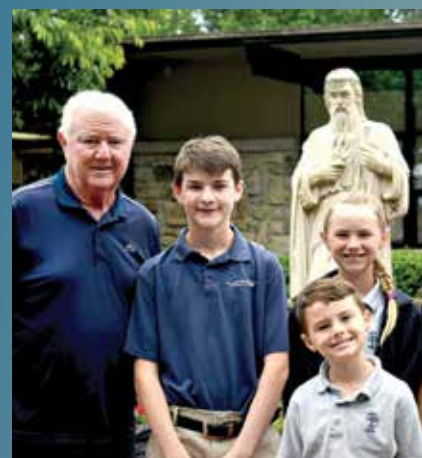
Family Day of Service

giving opportunities

Annual Fund Giving is a financial priority for our school. It is a tax-deductible opportunity for donors to help make a difference in the future of Saint Jude the Apostle Catholic School. Gifts are unrestricted and added to the school's budget to meet current operating expenses, to enhance the programs and services offered to students, and to maintain the school building. *The Annual Fund* offsets the difference between tuition and the actual cost to educate each student. Saint Jude does not receive a subsidy from either the parish or the Archdiocese of Atlanta. Each family is asked to contribute at a level appropriate for their financial situation. Our goal is 100% parent, faculty, and staff participation.

Endowment Fund Giving is an opportunity to invest in the future of Saint Jude School and an excellent way to invest in the future of Catholic education. Contributions to the Endowment Fund are perpetual, and as the Endowment grows, so does the school's ability to carry on its mission. *The Endowment Fund* was established in 2002 to ensure the future financial stability of Saint Jude the Apostle Catholic School. Memorial and honorary gifts can be allocated to the Endowment Fund at any time.

Guardian Angel Fund A donation to this fund provides a tax-deductible opportunity for donors and allows them to make a direct impact on a current student's ability to continue to pursue a Catholic education. Donors may provide full or partial tuition scholarships for a student or students in a family that demonstrates financial need.

St. Martin Scholarship Fund was established in 1996 to provide financial assistance for current Saint Jude School families who are experiencing an unexpected life crisis such as divorce, job loss, or death in the family.

Emily Johnston Scholarship Fund was established in 1988 by the Saint Jude Home and School Association in memory of Mrs. Emily Johnston, much-loved school librarian for 19 years. The fund provides tuition assistance to Saint Jude School families who demonstrate financial need.

Elizabeth Huffner Angel Fund was established in 2010 by Don Huffner in loving memory of his wife, Elizabeth, a former Saint Jude teacher. A scholarship is awarded each year to a current 5th grade student who possesses similar qualities as Elizabeth, particularly her love of literature.

Elizabeth "Bitsy" Davis Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 2011 by Kathy Davis Pepe in loving memory of her daughter, Bitsy, who was a Saint Jude student and a graduate of the Marist School. This scholarship is presented to a 5th grade girl, as Kathy taught 5th grade here at Saint Jude for over 20 years before joining administration. The recipient must possess an enthusiasm for living, be fun loving, yet a rule follower, a responsible student and exhibit kindness to everyone – all qualities Bitsy displayed during her life.

Regina Hersey Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 2012 by Brian Hersey to honor his cherished wife, Regina. Regina made such an impact on the Saint Jude Community and was greatly admired by faculty, parents, and students. Her selflessness and dedication were so evident in all her endeavors. This scholarship is presented to a deserving student whose family is actively involved with the PTA and school community.

Dr. Amy Bennett Bellows Book and Scholarship Award was established in 2013 by Brent R. Bellows in loving memory of his treasured wife, Amy. Amy was the proud mother of Jack and Will Bellows and was active in all aspects of their lives. Amy was also an avid Saint Jude School volunteer. Each year, a book and scholarship will be awarded to a 4th grade girl and boy committed to reading, achieving academic excellence, and loving God – all virtues Amy cherished, lived by, and strived to instill in her children each and every day.

Liz and Bill Oliver Memorial Scholarship Award was established in 2016 by long-time Saint Jude parishioner, Bill Oliver, to honor his beloved wife, Liz. This scholarship award is given annually to a current

seventh grader who goes above and beyond his or her service hour requirements, and is, overall, a well-rounded student. As helping others was near and dear to Liz, this award was established to recognize a student who has made an impact in the community through dedicated service to others.

Shane Matthew Connolly Memorial Scholarship Award was established in loving memory of Shane Connolly in 2021 by his parents, Patrick and Annie Connolly, and his sisters, Lauren, and Maeve ('03). Shane was a former student at Saint Jude and a graduate of the Marist School. The scholarship is awarded to a rising 8th grader, boy or girl, who demonstrates outstanding achievement both in the classroom and on the playing field, and who does so while emulating Shane's humility, unfailingly even-tempered sportsmanship, and consistently exhibited concern for and kindness to others.

Christina Marie Wenke Memorial Scholarship Award was established in 2021 by an anonymous Saint Jude School family together with Lisa Wenke, in loving memory of her daughter, Christina, who attended Saint Jude School from kindergarten through 8th grade. Christina was a ray of sunshine, appropriate as yellow was her favorite color! She was loving, kind, and compassionate. Beautiful both inside and out, Christina was not attention seeking, yet had a sweet, spirited personality and radiated joy and happiness to all. This scholarship will be awarded to a 5th grade student, boy or girl, whose quiet 'unsung hero' demeanor and contagious smile best exemplifies our angel, Christina.

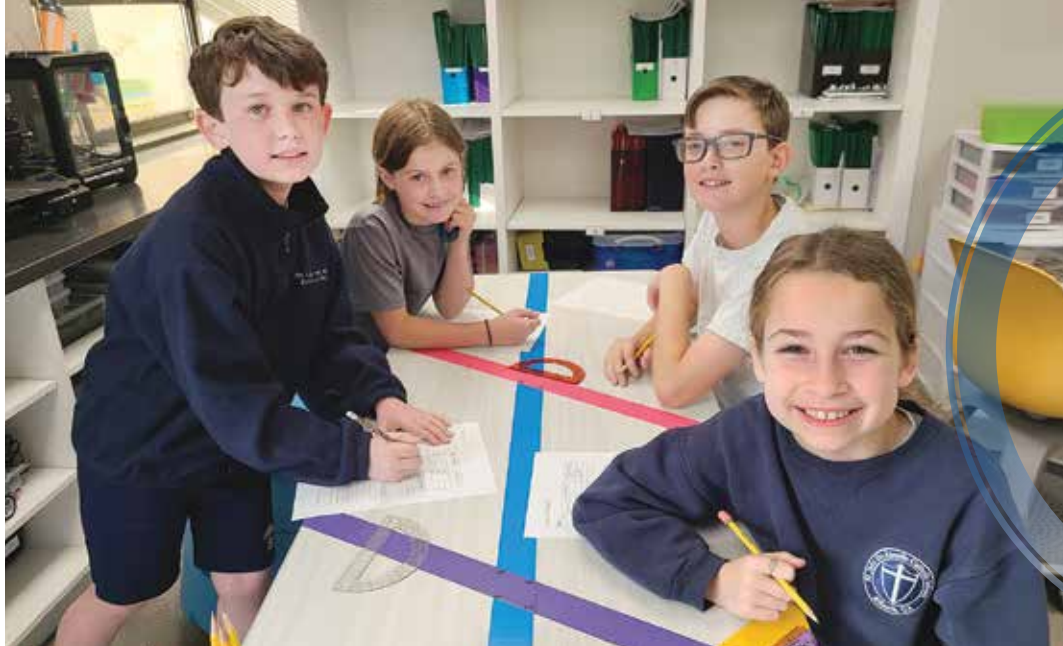
